

Keep in mind transitions have different meanings, nuances, and connections. Before using, be sure your selection follows the logic you're presenting.

For addition or sequence—*actually, additionally, after (this), afterward, afterwards, again, also, alternatively, and, and then, another... besides (this), as a matter of fact, as well (as this), at first, equally important, either (neither), even more, eventually, finally, first... second, secondly, etc.... third, first of all, for a start, further, furthermore, in addition (to this), in all honesty, indeed, in fact, in the first, second, etc.) place, initially, last, lastly, later, let alone, likewise, meanwhile, moreover, much less, next, not to mention (this), on the other hand, or, other, overall, previously, nor, still, subsequently, then, to begin with, too, to say nothing of, to start with, to tell the truth, what is more, what's more.*

For condition—*as/so long as, even if, in case, in the event that, given that, granted (that), granting (that), if, only if, on (the) condition (that), provided that, providing that, unless.*

For concession—*admittedly, albeit, although, be that as it may, but even so, certainly, conceding that, despite (this), even though, granted that, granted (this), in fact, in spite of (this), it is true that, it may appear that, naturally, nevertheless, no doubt, nonetheless, notwithstanding (this), of course, on the other hand, regardless (of this), (and) still, surely, though, to be sure, undoubtedly, without a doubt, (and) yet.*

For conflict—*but, by way of contrast, conversely, however, in contrast, on the other hand, still, though (final position), when in fact, whereas, while, (and) yet.*

For comparison/contrast—*after all, alternatively, although, and yet, at the same time, but, by the same token, conversely, despite, even so, even though, for all that, however, in contrast, in like manner, in similar fashion, in spite of, instead, in the same manner, likewise, nevertheless, nonetheless, nor, notwithstanding, on the contrary, on the other hand, or, otherwise, similarly, regardless, still, though, yet.*

For consequence—*if not, if so, in that case, otherwise, that being the case, then, under those circumstances.*

For dismissal—*all the same, at any rate, either way, in any case, in any event, in either case, in either event, whatever happens, whichever happens.*

For digression—*by the way, incidentally, to change the topic.*

For examples, clarification, emphasis, identification—*above all, after all, an instance of this, as an illustration, besides, by all means, certainly, clearly, definitely, doubtedly, e.g. (for example), even, even more, for example, for instance, for one thing, i.e. (that is), importantly, indeed, in fact, in other words, in particular, in short, more importantly, more than that, namely, no, of course, of major concern, once again, specifically, somewhat, such as, surely, that is, that is to say, the following example, this can be seen in, thus, to clarify, to demonstrate, to explain, to illustrate, to repeat, to rephrase (it), to put it another way, truly, undoubtedly, without a doubt, without doubt, yes.*

For qualification—*almost, although, always, frequently, habitually, maybe, nearly, never, oftentimes, often, perhaps, probably, time and again*

For replacement—*(or) at least, instead, (or) rather.*

For result—*accordingly, and so, as a consequence, as a result, as an outcome, because, consequently, for this reason, hence, in consequence, so, so much (so) that, so that, then, therefore, thereupon, thus.*

For reference—*as for (this), concerning (this), considering (this), on the subject of (this), regarding (this), speaking about (this), the fact that, with regards to (this).*

For resumption—*anyhow, anyway, at any rate, to get back to the point, to resume, to return to the subject.*

For similarity—*again, also, and, as well as, besides, but the same token, equally, for example, furthermore, in a like manner, in a similar way, in the same way, like, likewise, moreover, once more, similarly, so.*

For summary or conclusion—*after all, all in all, altogether, as a final point, as a result, as has been mentioned, as has been noted, as I have said, as mentioned earlier, as stated, as was previously stated, as we have seen, at any event, at last, briefly, clearly, consequently, eventually, finally, hence, given these points, in all, in a word, in brief, in conclusion, in other words, in particular, in short, in simpler terms, in sum, in summary, in the end, lastly, on the whole, overall, so, that is, then, therefore, thus, to be brief, to conclude, to put it briefly, to summarize, to sum up.*

For time—*after, after a bit, after a few days, after a while, afterward, afterwards, again, also, always, and then, as long as, as soon as, at first, at last, at length, at that time, at the same time, before, during, earlier, eventually, finally, first, following, formerly, further, hence, initially, immediately, in a few days, in the first place, in the future, in the meantime, in the past, last, lately, later, meanwhile, never, next, now, on (a certain day), once, presently, previously, recently, second, shortly, simultaneously, since, so far, sometimes, soon, still, subsequently, then, thereafter, this time, today, tomorrow, until, until now, when, whenever, while.*
